Accessing Seesaw

1. For children to access Seesaw at home you will need to download the Seesaw **CLASS** app. More info can be found here about the app:

To access assigned work:

1. Children will need to click on the Seesaw CLASS app and then select 'I am a student'




2. Login with your QR code or student code (if you haven't got this, please send a message on our 'Chat with Us!' feature on our website- www.mwcp.co.uk)
